All fees are inclusive of VAT at the prevailing rate of 20%.

*A £249+VAT pupil device levy will be added to the fees for P6, S1 and S3 in 2024/25 to cover phase 1 of the School's rollout of pupil devices. This will be an annual fee from 25/26 for all pupils.

Sibling discounts are available as follows:

Eldest of 4 50% discount. Eldest of 3 25% discount

In calculating eligibility for sibling discounts, only full fee paying pupils are taken into account, e.g. for a family of 3 where 1 child is in the preschool/nursery and receiving funding, then the eldest of 3 would not be eligible for a discount.

Please note that eligible families can only receive one form of discount or financial support, e.g. if a family is in receipt of a bursary, they cannot also receive a sibling discount.



FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

From its inception in 1641 by the Hutcheson brothers, our charitable purpose has been clear, and our mission is to target our support to those who need it most. We offer financial assistance in two ways:

Transformational bursaries – where 100% of the fees are paid for.

Fees assistance bursaries – where a fraction of the fees are paid for by the family, with the remainder, up to 100%, paid for by the school.

In a typical year, we are enormously proud that around one in ten youngsters are in receipt of bursary support. It should be noted that despite our extensive fundraising we have a limited bursary pot. For S1 entry, we warmly welcome bursary applications from those who are truly in need. Regretfully, we are not able to offer bursary support to those joining us in later years, or in Primary. Those who perform better in our S1 entrance test will be prioritised alongside their financial need as we decide who receives a bursary offer, and whether it is transformational or to the level of fee assistance.

Following a bursary application, a careful and thorough set of checks is made on detailed evidence supplied by the family. This ranges from family income, where parents whose joint income is more than £65,000 are unlikely to be successful, to assets held such as property, businesses, size, and ownership of family home, etc.
